1. Regarding the Georgia Pain Management Update – July 2008. Georgia increased its grade from a D+ to a B. This is the largest increase any state has ever recorded. For information only.

The American Cancer Society Pain Initiative, of which Ms. Hughes is a member wrote a grant last week and received \$8,000.00 dollars to start the pain initiative in Georgia, not just for pain management, to get information into the medical schools to make residents aware of how to prescribe for pain.
3. DHR received a grant to set up an emergency system for advance registration of voluntary Health care professionals: State Emergency Registrars of Volunteers. The Medical Board is involved by providing the database of physicians, physician's assistants, and respiratory care professionals. For information only.
