Dr. Sumner called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

**AGENDA**

Dr. Woolery moved to approve the agenda of the August 7-8, 2008 CSBME meeting as amended.  
Dr. Summers seconded, and it carried unanimously.

**MINUTES**

Dr. Woolery moved to approve the minutes of the July 10-11 2008 CSBME meeting with an amendment on page three. Dr. Summers seconded and it carried unanimously.

**TELEMEDICINE REPORT**

Dr. Lee presented the report of the Telemedicine Committee, for information only.

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1. Reviewed a presentation given to the Committee by Paula Guy on the state of telemedicine in Georgia. She noted that the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget was currently discussing telemedicine options as a way to reduce the costs of health care delivery by state government, and that the Georgia Department of Corrections has utilized telemedicine since 1992, and now has 18 telemedicine sites.
2. Reviewed Ms. Guy's presentation to the Committee that Georgia law (O.C.G.A. 33-24-56.4) defined telemedicine and that the statute further stated that "standard telephone, facsimile transmissions, unsecured electronic mail, or a combination thereof do not constitute telemedicine services." Ms. Guy added that Medicare defined the following telemedicine services as being eligible for reimbursement: consultation, office visits, and individual psychotherapy and pharmacologic management delivered via a telecommunications system, which may substitute for a face-to-face "hands-on" encounter.
3. Dr. Lee advised that physicians can add telemedicine riders to their existing malpractice policies.
4. Reviewed a report Dr. Roundtree presented to the committee on the use of electronic medical records and on e-prescribing. He noted that these would become mandatory for Medicare reimbursement in 2012 and 2010, respectively.
5. Reviewed the proposed language of Rule 360-3-.02, which the Board had sent to the Attorney General for advice in June 2008.

**RADIOLOGY PRACTITIONER ASSISTANT**

Kathy Kemle, PA-C, presented a report on Radiology Practitioner Assistants. Since the Radiology Practitioner Assistants (RPA) are unlicensed the physician can not delegate authority to them. Dr. Sumner requested Ms. Kemle poll hospitals to see how many RPA's there are, and give a report to the PA Committee at the September board meeting.

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**APPEARANCE BEFORE THE BOARD**

GEORGIA BOARD OF PHARMACY – GEORGIA DRUGS AND NARCOTICS AGENCY–  
Regarding flu immunizations.

Steve Wilson, Pharmacy Board member, Judy Gardner, Pharmacy Board member, and Rick Allen, Deputy Director of Drugs and Narcotics presented information pertaining to the necessity of declaring an emergency concerning the administering of flu shots for this winter. The Board asked questions of the Pharmacy Board members, and they responded.

Dr. Gross seconded and it carried unanimously.
